## Parking and Shuttle Information

Two lots will be available for the *FIRST* Robotic event. There is a special rate of \$5.00 per day set up. Please use vouchers on the event website, and show this when you exit the parking lot and \$5.00 will be the rate you pay. \*\* Each day you need a voucher.

- **Vol Hall Public Parking Voucher needed**—Please use vouchers on the event website, and show this when you exit the parking lot and \$5.00 will be the rate you pay. \*\* Each day you need a voucher. Saturday is Vol Hall is open and **FREE**. **\*\*Lot is a distance from the venue... Take a campus shuttle. Lot for Thursday and Friday.**
- **Fraternity Park** Each day guests will need to pay \$5.00 at the Transit Office (located at 2121 Stephenson Drive off Neyland Drive) and get a permit. **\*\*Lot walking distance to venue**

Fraternity Park only has event parking in the two middle sections designated as GF2 & GF3 located on Todd Helton Drive—use 1521 Todd Helton Dr 37996 in Google Maps

\*\*Please note that trailers and busses are to use Stephenson Drive lot.

\*\* Refer to the attached campus map for parking lots.

Parking is not available at parking lots adjacent to the Arena when classes are in session during the week on March 22, 23 & 24. **SATURDAY- There is NO shuttle service.** To avoid a long walk please plan on parking in **G10** adjacent to the venue.

## Shuttles

- Campus shuttles do run **Monday-Friday** until 6:00PM and they will run from Vol Hall Parking to the arena.
- Special arrangements have been made for the shuttles to run until 9:00PM on both **Thursday and Friday**. There will be two shuttle running loops **until 9:00PM**. These shuttles will pick up in front of the arena and drop off at the **Vol Hall Parking lot**.

## Handicapped Parking

Visitor handicapped parking requires individuals to obtain a free accessible parking permit when they show a valid unexpired state-issued handicap parking placard or license plate. These permits must be obtained before a vehicle is parked and these are available at the Circle Park Information Booth or at the UT Parking Office located at 2121 Stephenson Drive.
